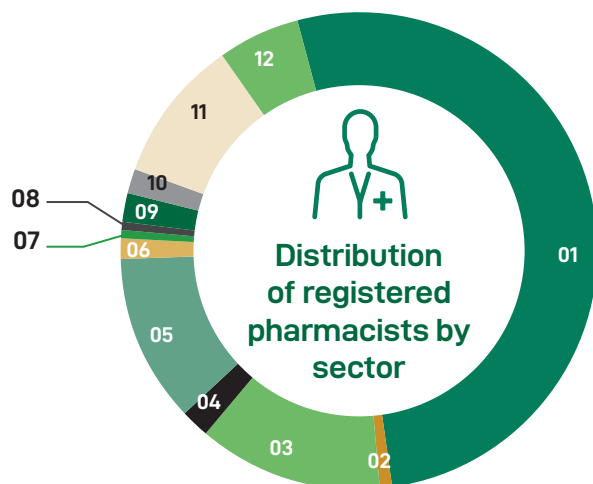

The digital transformation strategy is structured around Nodofarma, a communication network among the Chambers acting as a platform for technological services.



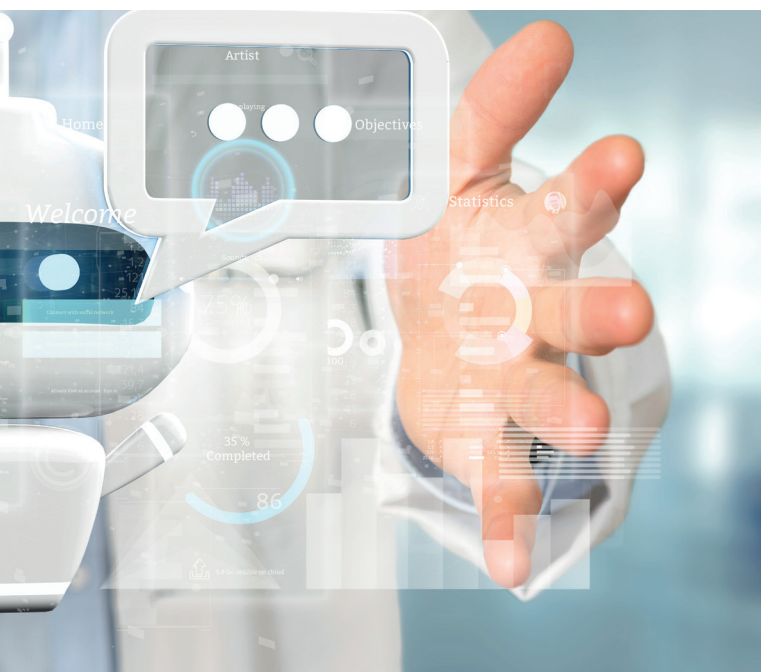
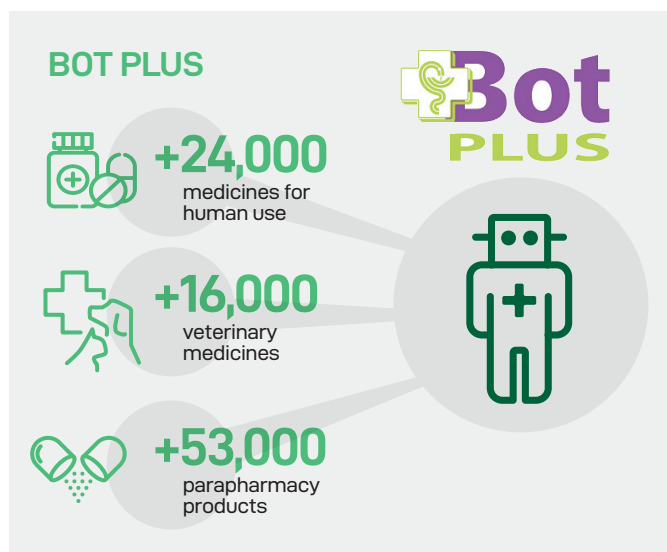
Digitalisation of pharmaceutical provision

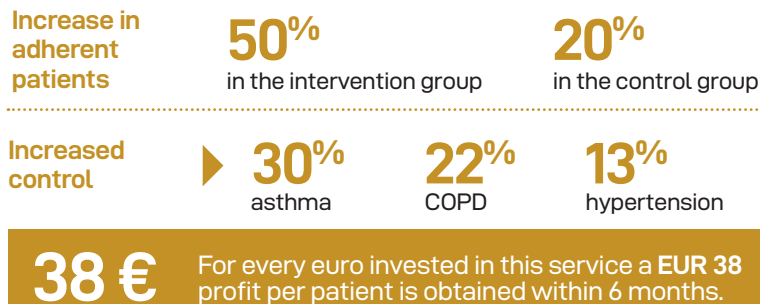

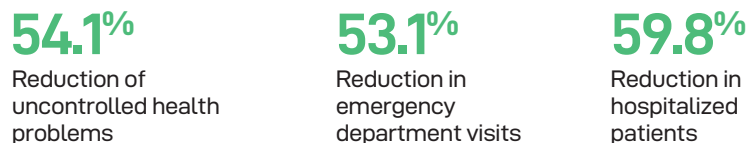

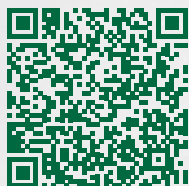
