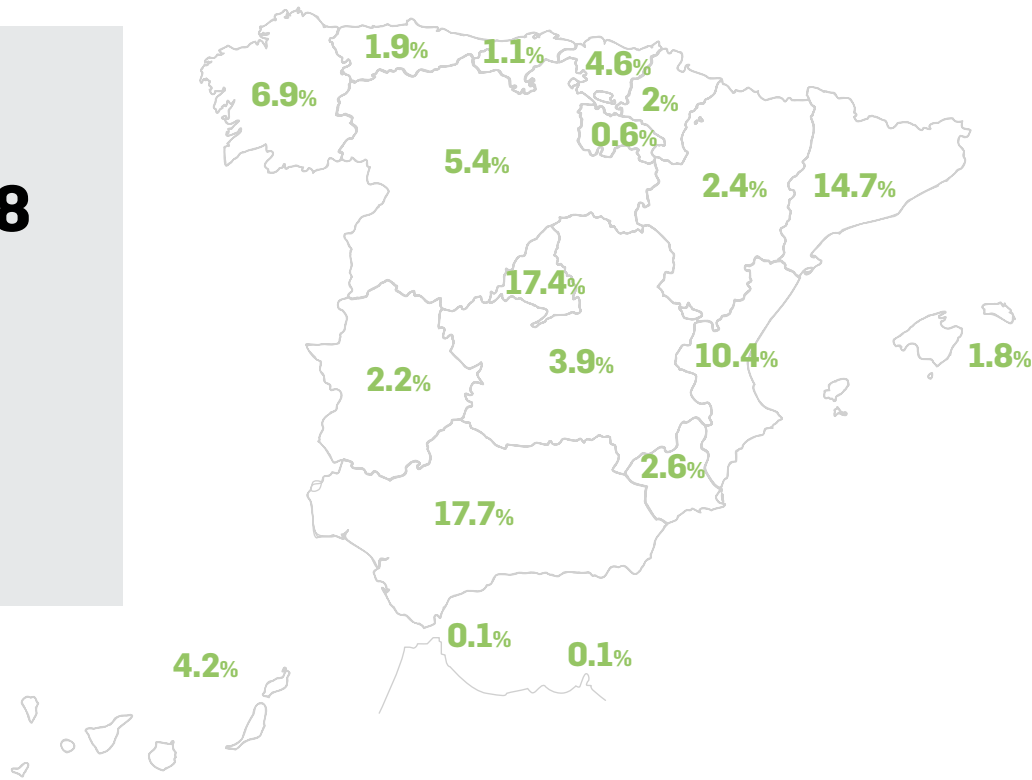

Registered member distribution by Regions



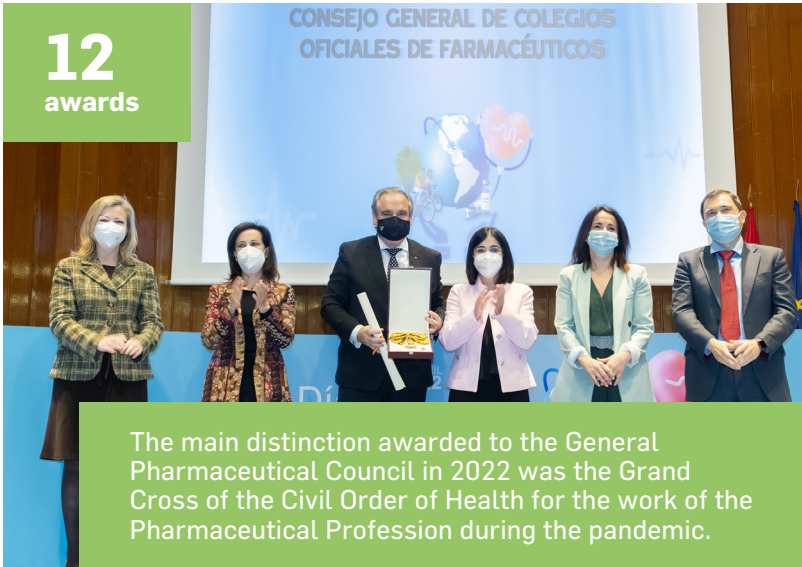

Transformative encounters: Seville in figures

Hosting the 80th World Congress of Pharmacy and Pharmaceutical Sciences and the 22nd Spanish National Pharmacy Congress in Seville at the same time is a historic milestone for the profession, as it is the first international meeting after the pandemic.

At the event, which brought together 5,000 professionals from more than 100 countries, the participants discussed the lessons learned during the global health crisis and the key aspects that will determine the evolution of the profession in the coming years, highlighting the leadership of the Spanish model.
